The Manager, Quality Assurance is responsible for the development, administration and maintenance of the Quality Assurance Management System to assure that all products and services provided by Selas meet client expectations, applicable specifications and standards in order to achieve documented quality, reliability and performance levels. This position is also responsible for overseeing ISO certification, Six Sigma and Toyota Lean Manufacturing initiatives.

- Coordinate all activities within Selas Fluid necessary to maintain ISO 9001, 2008 certification. This includes the implementation of the Linde Integrated Management System.
- Institute Toyota Lean Manufacturing initiatives and 5S to facilitate a more streamlined fabrication process and process efficiency in the workplace.
- Meet with vendors, customer, quality representatives and company personnel to discuss and resolve quality issues as needed. Perform root cause analyses as needed.
- Develop and maintain Selas Fluid's activities in relation to the Linde Group's Six Sigma Program
- Monitor quality of products and services throughout project base in order to sight areas of improvement and necessary corrective actions
- Develop, review and update quality assurance documentation such as Inspection Attribute Lists, Inspection/Welding Specifications and Vendor Data Requirements for product lines in cooperation with Selas Fluid Engineering and project Management Departments
- Review and acceptance of vendor welding procedures, NDE procedures and Inspection Test Plans
- Hands-on coordination with the Client's personnel and Selas Fluid Engineering, Procurement, Expediting, Site Construction and Project Management departments to improve quality of products and services
